DISTRICT RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING WATER SERVICE - PART 5: CHARGES: MISCELLANEOUS FEES (ADMINISTRATIVE COST RECOVERIES)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that BCVWD is considering modifying miscellaneous fees.

Reason for proposed fees and charges and basis for charges: BCVWD is committed to providing safe and reliable water services in a cost-effective manner while protecting water resources and the public's health. Costs of materials, labor, and operations have increased. The District must modify some of its fees and charges to reflect current costs of providing services, bring fees closer to full cost recovery, and assure that costs are being recovered from those who incur the expense of providing the service.

The proposed increases are the result of a detailed budget analysis / update following the independent professional Water Financial Plan and Utility Rate Study prepared in 2021 to determine the appropriateness of the proposed fees and the fair and equitable allocation of same. Upon request, a copy of the Water Financial Plan and Utility Rate Study and 2024 staff report, analysis, and proposed fee schedule may be obtained at the District's Administrative Office located at 560 Magnolia Avenue, Beaumont, California, 92223 or by visiting the District website at www.bcvwd.org.

If adopted, the increased fees will become effective beginning April 1, 2024 or as determined by the Board of Directors.

At the date, time and location specified above, the Board of Directors will conduct a Public Hearing to consider the proposed increases to fees and charges. The Public Hearing will be to solicit oral public testimony and receive written comments. The Board may continue the hearing without further written notice.

Written or emailed comments may be submitted to the Board of Directors prior to the hearing. Correspondence received during or after the meeting will be distributed to the Board of Directors as soon as practicable and retained for the official record. Send comments to:
