



Conditions of Development

If the Board of Directors approves the provision of temporary water service for the 2026 Cherry Festival, the following conditions shall apply:

1. The City of Beaumont shall submit a completed application for temporary water service and coordinate directly with District staff regarding meter locations, installation timing, and service duration.
2. All water service shall be provided exclusively through District-issued construction (fire hydrant) meters with approved backflow prevention devices.
3. The City shall be responsible for all District-issued equipment during the rental period, including loss, theft, or damage. Any repair or replacement costs shall be deducted from the deposit or billed accordingly.
4. Actual water charges will be based on metered consumption at the conclusion of the event.
5. The City shall comply with all applicable District Rules and Regulations, including Part 5 (Charges), and all applicable health and safety requirements.
6. Water shall be used solely for approved event purposes (e.g., vendor operations, sanitation, food preparation) and shall not be resold or redistributed outside the event.
7. All backflow devices shall remain in place and operational at all times. No modifications or bypassing of equipment is permitted.
8. District staff shall have the right to access the site at any time to inspect equipment, verify usage, and ensure compliance with District standards.
9. Temporary service shall be limited to the duration of the event, including reasonable setup and breakdown time as approved by the District.
10. Approval of this temporary service does not constitute a commitment by the District to provide permanent water service to the site in the future.
11. The City shall indemnify and hold harmless the District from any claims, damages, or liabilities arising from the use of temporary water service at the event.

Specific Conditions:

1. The City shall pay all applicable water usage charges, pass-through charges (SCE Power and SGPWA Importation), and meter rental fees in accordance with the District's adopted rate schedule.
2. Final billing shall be based on actual metered consumption and applicable rental duration. Payment shall be made in accordance with District billing procedures.
3. The waiver of charges shall be limited to water consumption fees only. All deposits and any costs associated with damage, loss, or misuse remain the responsibility of the City.
4. The fee waiver is granted as a one-time, event-specific accommodation and shall not establish precedent for future requests.
