

RESOLUTION 2026-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BEAUMONT-CHERRY VALLEY WATER DISTRICT ADOPTING THE 2025 SAN GORGONIO PASS REGIONAL URBAN WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 797 (Water Code Section 10610 et seq., known as the Urban Water Management Planning Act) during the 1983-84 Regular Session, and as amended subsequently, which mandates that every water supplier providing water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or supplying more than 3,000 acre-feet of water annually, prepare an Urban Water Management Plan and update it as required, the primary objective of which is to plan for the conservation and efficient use of water; and

WHEREAS, BCVWD is an urban water supplier delivering more than 12,000 acre-feet of water annually to over 22,000 connections; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Water Code Section 10621, the UWMP is to be updated every five years to assess the reliability of water sources over a 20-year planning horizon, and is to be submitted to the Department of Water Resources for review and acceptance by July 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Water Code, a Notice of Preparation of the 2025 San Gorgonio Pass Regional Urban Water Management Plan was distributed on December 16, 2025 to the cities, counties, agencies and interested parties within the BCVWD service area, and notice of public hearing and availability for public inspection of the Plan was posted on June 5, 2026, and the draft 2025 San Gorgonio Pass Regional UWMP was posted to the BCVWD website for public inspection on June 5, 2026; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Water Code, notification of the public hearing and circulation of the draft plan was also published in the Beaumont Record-Gazette on June 5, 2026 and June 12, 2026 pursuant to Government Code §6066; and

WHEREAS, the properly noticed public hearing was held by the BCVWD Board of Directors on June 25, 2026,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Beaumont-Cherry Valley Water District:

1. The 2025 San Gorgonio Pass Regional Urban Water Management Plan is hereby adopted, including modifications to the 2025 San Gorgonio Pass Regional Urban Water Management Plan made after the Public Hearing by the General Manager limited to (i) de minimis refinements, and (ii) such changes to address public input received (if any) at the Public Hearing.
2. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to file the 2025 San Gorgonio Pass Regional Urban Water Management Plan immediately after its adoption with the California Department of Water Resources, and within thirty (30) days to the California State Library - Government Publications Section, and any city or county within which the District provides water supplies.

3. The General Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take any necessary actions to implement and administer the 2025 San Gorgonio Pass Regional Urban Water Management Plan.

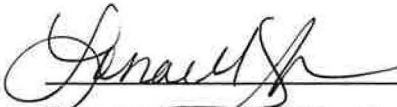

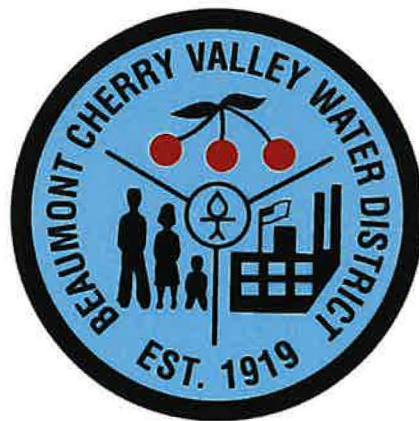
